REMODELING WORKER CAUGHT STEALING DRUGS FROM BUSINESS



A Fort Walton Beach man working to help remodel a Publix grocery store faces multiple charges after being caught on camera breaking into the pharmacy storage area to steal prescription medications.

41-year old Jason Dewayne Jordan of 210 Texas Street is charged with two counts of burglary of a structure involving theft of medication, grand theft of controlled substances, trafficking in opium and criminal mischief.

Employees at the Publix located at 610 North Eglin Parkway discovered a large amount of various prescription drugs missing from the pharmacy area April 20th. Surveillance video showed Jordan use a pry tool to enter the pharmacy April 15th and again April 20th. Investigators estimate Jordan took more than 35-hundred dollars worth of amphetamines, hydrocodone, and various bottle of oxycodone.

[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On April 20, 2015, members of the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office Patrol Division responded to 610 N. Eglin Parkway, Fort Walton Beach, Florida, further identified as Publix Supermarket, in reference to theft complaint.

Upon arrival D/S Megan Hankins made contact with the regional loss prevention manager Nicole Strange who advised D/S Hankins they had discovered a large amount of various prescription medications were missing from the secure pharmacy area. Review of the pharmacy surveillance footage showed the Defendant, later identified as Jason D. Jordan, forcefully enter the pharmacy using a pry tool on two separate occasions.

On April 15, 2015, the surveillance footage shows the Defendant enter the pharmacy at which point he began to search through the prescription medications in an attempt to find desired types of medications. The surveillance video displays the Defendant pick up numerous types of medications while inside. Based on inventory, the only medication known to have been taken at this time was Xanax.

On April 20, 2015, at approximately 0300 hours, the surveillance footage shows the Defendant again enter the pharmacy at which point he went directly to a separate locked cabinet containing various medication to include opiates. Based on inventory, the medication known to have been taken at this time include: Amphetamines, Hydrocodone, and various bottles of oxycodone.

As a result of the forced entry into the pharmacy cabinet, the lock on the cabinet sustained damage which was estimated at approximately \$20.00. The value of all medication stolen was estimated (at this time) at approximately \$3,513.49. (It should be noted that additional charges are pending once a final count of all missing medication has been completed.)

Investigator Dennis Fields arrived on scene a short time thereafter and advised the Defendant of his Miranda rights. Post Miranda the Defendant initially admitted to stealing three bottles of OxyContin which he stated were not full. The Defendant admitted that he possessed approximately 10 OxyContin pills, in his vehicle, along with a small amount of marijuana.

The Defendant further identified his home address at 8 NE Gipson Place, Apt. 6, Fort Walton Beach, Florida. The Defendant stated that the remainder of the stolen medications were located at his residence. The Defendant was escorted to his residence at which point he provided Investigator Fields with written consent to search his residence. During the search of the residence multiple medications/bottles were located which included some of the types of medications reported stolen.

One of the bottles of medication located in the Defendant's residence was a bottle of 40mg OxyContin. The bottle was found to contain approximately 190 pills with markings "OP 40" tentatively identified as 40mg OxyContin (oxycodone hydrochloride). The total weight of these pills is approximately 30 grams.

Based on the aforementioned information your Affiant has reason to believe the Defendant, Jason D. Jordan, did violate F.S.S. 810.02(3f) Burglary of a Structure Involving Theft of Medication (2 counts), F.S.S. 812.014(2c13) Grand Theft of Controlled Substances, F.S.S. Criminal Mischief less than \$200.00, and F.S.S. 893.135(1c1) Trafficking Opium or Derivative (>28 grams to 30 kilograms). These offenses did occur in Okaloosa County, Florida.
