[STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE / NARRATIVE]

On 02/08/2016, at approximately 0904 hours, the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office responded to 203 Ann Circle, Unit 3, Destin, FL in reference to an Armed Home Invasion Robbery.

Upon arrival, contact was made with the female victim, Norma Orozco, at unit 3. Per sworn affidavit of complaint and verbal statements, the victim related she returned home, at approximately 0845, from dropping her children off school. Orozco was in the bathroom when she heard a knock at her door. When she got to the door, an individual identified himself as "Luis." When she opened the door slightly, to see who it was, two suspects forced the door open and entered the house without invitation. The suspects began shouting, "Where is the money?" Orozco replied that she did not have any money. The suspects forced Orozco to the ground and duct taped her hands behind her back and around her face. One suspect was armed with a knife approximately 10" long, and the other suspect was armed with a black revolver. Orozco

stated they kept demanding money and repeatedly kicked and punched her. One suspect held a knife to her throat and the other suspect went to the back bedroom and began going through the dresser drawers. According to Orozco, the suspect with the knife threatened to kill her if she did not tell him where the money was. The suspect with the gun came back out to Orozco and put the gun to her head and said, "Where is the money?" Orozco then stated something spooked the suspects and they ran out of the house and down Ann Circle towards Legion Drive. Orozco stated the above acts placed her in genuine fear for her life.

During this time a witness saw a suspicious truck parked in Orozco's driveway and began calling her to check on her. After receiving no answer the witness walked to Orozco's apartment and saw two males flee the apartment. The witness went inside and observed Orozco bound with duct tape and called law enforcement.

A second witness stated he saw a truck parked in front of 207 Ann Circle apartment 5 for approximately 20 minutes prior to Orozco returning home. Approximately three minutes after Orozco returned home, the truck relocated to Orozco's driveway. The witness observed two males from the truck enter into Orozco's apartment and ten minutes later the same two males exited the apartments with weapons in hand and began running after the truck which had departed. The witness gave chase of the two males but lost sight of them in the area of Indian Village Townhomes.

Both witnesses described the truck as a beige Toyota Tundra. Per the victim the two male suspects were possible Honduran due to their accent. One was tall and skinny, the second was short, skinny and had a small amount of facial hair. The physical description provided by Orozco matched the physical description of the males observed fleeing the apartment by witnesses.

Orozco stated the short male with facial hair was the one armed with a knife and threatening to kill her while he had the knife pressed against her throat.

Deputy David Finke removed the duct tape bindings from Orozco upon his arrival. This tape was collected as evidence along with the leather knife sheath and roll of duct tape the suspects dropped inside the doorway to the apartment.

A third witness contacted the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office a short time later after observing two Hispanic males run through her neighbor's yard and jump her privacy fence. The address was identified as 229 Indian Oaks Drive. This address in two streets east of Ann Circle. The witness described one male as being bald and carrying a black sweater or shirt on his arm and the other was tall and skinny. One of the males had facial hair, both were in their 30's. The witness lost sight after the males jumped and broke the wooden fence. They were last seen heading east towards Legion Village Town Homes.

Approximately 0944 hours, Deputy Sean Neumann located the defendant, Santos De Jesus Chirinos-Calix walking on Mattie Kelly Bd. Mattie Kelly Bd is approximately 1 mile from Ann Circle. The defendant matched the physical description of one of the suspects. Deputy Neumann had seen the defendant several minutes earlier in the area of Legion Village Townhomes which is less than one block east of Ann Circle while enroute to another priority call. Upon the defendant seeing Deputy Neumann he attempted to turn his body to avoid detection. The defendant was detained upon Deputy Neumann making contact with him on Mattie Kelly and a "Show-up" was conducted with the witnesses. Witnesses positively identified the defendant as the male suspect who was armed with a knife running from Orozco's apartment.

The defendant had a tear in his right front pants leg and a scrape on his right elbow, both of which would have been sustained jumping the fence on Indian Oaks Drive.

The victim was shown a picture of the defendant and also positively identified the defendant as the one who stated he was

"Luis" and then held the knife to her throat threatening to kill her.

After the positive identification by the witnesses, the defendant was transported to the Criminal Investigation Division in Shalimar for an interview. The defendant claimed to speak no English and as such Deputy Miguel Rojas was requested for translation purposes. Post Miranda, the defendant, claimed to have only been in Destin for three days recently moving here from Houston, Texas. The defendant denied any involvement in this case. He gave numerous different accounts of his whereabouts prior to the incident on Ann Circle and claimed to have been alone all morning walking around Destin. The defendant purposely avoided putting himself in the area of Ann Circle several time when asked where he was walking

When confronted with the known facts, the defendant stated we must be confused. The defendant changed his testimony twice about how he sustained the damage to his pants, he first stated he tore it while doing exercises yesterday and then later when asked about it again he stated he did it at work when he got snagged on a metal pipe.

The defendant consented to the taking of his DNA by buccal swabs and to a download of his cellular phone. During a review of his cellular phone, numerous calls were made to a select few phone numbers. One of the phone numbers possessed an 850 area code. The defendant claimed the number belonged to a male co-worker from Houston, Texas. The defendant claimed the defendant was not in the area and was still in Texas. All calls and texts stop during the time of the robbery and the start back up at approximately 0909 hours, just minutes after the defendant was chased down Ann Circle by the witnesses.

Based on the totality of the investigation, I have reason to believe the defendant, Santos De Jesus Chirinos-Calix, did knowingly and willingly commit the acts of Armed Home Invasion Robbery, Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon and Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon. These acts are in direct violation of F.S.S. 810.02(2a), 784.021(1a) and 784.045(1a2). The offenses occurred in Okaloosa County Florida where your affiant is a sworn full time law enforcement officer who has been employed with the Okaloosa County Sheriff's Office for the last ten years. Your affiant is currently assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division.
