PRESS RELEASE

William Eddins, State Attorney for the First Judicial Circuit, announced that on August 12, 2014, Chloe Patricia Johnson entered a plea to 1st Degree Felony Murder and Attempted 1st Degree Felony Murder.

The charges arose from the June 27th, 2013 shooting death of Terrance Robinson at the Spanish Villa Apartments in Fort Walton Beach. She was one of three defendants who set up a drug deal with Terrance Robinson with the intent to rob Robinson of money and/or drugs. Johnson was not present at the time, but was responsible for setting up the deal with knowledge that Robinson would be robbed.

Keenan Stacks and Benjamin Rumlin are currently set for trial in October. Johnson faces a potential life sentence in prison at the time of sentencing. Johnson has been scheduled for sentencing on November 19, 2014.

The investigation was conducted by the Fort Walton Beach Police Department. Assistant State Attorney Angela Mason is responsible for the prosecution.
