The Crestview Police Department has arrested an Armed Robbery Suspect, within minutes of the crime. Officers of the Crestview Police Department responded to Sonic Drive In located at 1850 South Ferdon Boulevard last night, July,10, 2014, just before midnight, after employees advised that had just been robbed at knife point. The victim advised that the suspect came into the business and held a knife to their throat and demanded all of money.

As Officer arrived on scene, the Crestview Police Department received a second call regarding a second robbery of a person using the ATM machine located at Eglin Federal Credit Union located at 1490 South Ferdon Boulevard, which is located one block north of Sonic Drive In.

Multiple officers began canvassing the area meticulously and were able to locate a person matching the description of the suspect in the area. After being identified, the Crestview Police Department arrested the robbery suspect.

The Crestview Police Department has arrested 26 year old, black female, Tynesha M. Lewis of Crestview, and charged her with Armed Robbery with a Deadly Weapon, Aggravated Battery with a Deadly Weapon, and Armed Burglary to an Occupied Conveyance.

Tynesha M. Lewis was transported and delivered into the custody of the Okaloosa County Jail without incident, and as of the time of this release, she remains in custody without bond.
