Speed Limit Reduced on S.R. 123 in Okaloosa County

Chipley- In an effort to increase safety, the speed limit along State Road (S.R.) 123 in Okaloosa County from north of Turkey Creek to S.R. 85N and on S.R. 85N at the intersection of S.R. 123 has been reduced to 45 mph. Motorists are advised to be mindful of the reduced speed zones and to drive accordingly. Speeding fines are doubled in construction zones when workers are present.

Monday, Sept. 15, excavation of a stormwater pond on the east side of S.R. 123, north of Turkey Creek, will begin. Drivers will notice large trucks entering and exiting the construction area as they remove dirt from the site. Motorists are reminded to travel with care and to watch for construction equipment and workers entering and exiting the roadway.

Planned construction activities are weather-dependent and may be rescheduled in the event of inclement weather.
